Please see the following technical information about what data is collected and how it is processed:

1. Introduction

1.1. In adopting this Privacy Policy, we wish to balance our legitimate business interests when collecting and using your information and your reasonable expectation of privacy. In this respect, we will take all reasonable steps to prevent unauthorised access to your personal information.

1.2. Please note, we cannot guarantee that your personal information shall at all times be 100% secure since no security system on the internet can offer a 100% secure guarantee. We do however take all reasonable steps to our website against hackers by using secure hosting environments and installing the necessary plugins to harden the website security protocols.

1.3. By continuing to use our website, or any of our services you agree and are deemed to accept the terms and conditions of this Privacy Policy.

1.4. You also agree and accept that we may collect, process and/or store your personal information (as defined in the ECT Act) provided by you if you enter your details in the online contact form.

2. Collection of Usage Data

2.1. Usage Data is collected automatically when using our website through tracking cookies however, this information collected passively using various technologies is strictly for statistical purposes and to determine the visitor traffic patterns through our website and cannot be used by us to specifically identify you or extract personal information.

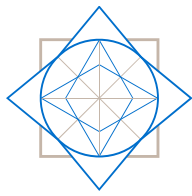
2.2. Google Analytics data may include information such as your browser type, the pages of our website that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

2.3. When you access our website through a mobile device, we may collect certain information automatically, including, but not limited to, the type of mobile device you use, your mobile device unique ID, your mobile operating system, the type of mobile Internet browser you use, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data. We may also collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our website or when you access our website by or through a mobile device.

3. What Personal Information is Collected

3.1. Only the details you provide by entering your information into the online contact form. This information normally includes your name, email address, contact number and occasionally your website address.

3.2. By entering your personal information into the online contact forms, you consent to provide us with your details we will use to send you the appropriate information required for you to use our products or services.



4. How Your Personal Information is Used

4.1. The primary goal in collecting your personal information is to provide you with a better customer experience, which may include, interactive communications and other services.

4.2. Your personal information may be used to:

4.2.1. 5. With whom is your information shared?

5.2. Your personal information may also be shared under the following circumstances:

5.3. If we need to create accounts for products or services and they need to be registered in your name.

5.4. Where the law requires that we disclose your personal information in special cases, where we have reason to believe that such disclosure is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against a party.

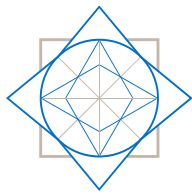
6. What are Cookies and How are They Used?

6.1. Cookies are pieces of information that a website transfers to a user's hard drive for record-keeping purposes. Cookies make surfing the web easier for you by saving your preferences and tracking your online habits, traffic patterns, and making sure you do not see the same advertisement too often. These files do not contain personal data, but they do contain a personal identifier allowing some websites to associate your personal data with a certain device. The use of cookies is an industry standard.

6.2. We do not extract personal information from cookies nor are we affiliated with any marketing company that uses services to match identifiers with personal information.

6.3. We may place a "cookie" on your browser to store and sometimes track information about you and the use of our website.

6.4. While most browsers are initially set up to accept cookies, you can reset your browser to refuse all cookies or indicate when a cookie is being sent. Please, note that some parts of our website will not function properly if you refuse cookies. You may occasionally get cookies from third party advertisers. We do not control these third-party cookies. The use of advertising cookies sent by third-party advertisers is an industry standard.



7. The Types of Cookies We Use

7.1. We use different types of cookies on our website. These cookies may be deleted from your device at different times, such as at the end of your browsing session (when you leave the website) or after a pre-set amount of time, or they may persist on your device until you delete them.

7.2. We use the following types of cookies on our website:

7.3. Essential cookies – these are cookies that allow our website to perform its essential functions. Without these cookies, some parts of our websites would stop working.

7.4. Site analytics cookies – these are cookies that monitor how our website is performing, and how you interact with it. We use them to know how best to improve our website or services.

7.5. Functional cookies – these are cookies that remember who you are as a user of our website. We use them to remember any preferences you may have selected on our website, like saving your username and password or settings.

8. Security of Personal Information

8.1. Overall website security and the protection of all personal information associated with you is of the utmost concern to us. While we exercise great care in providing secure transmission of your personal information, no data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. We therefore cannot guarantee the security of any information you transmit to, or from our website. We do however take all reasonable and appropriate measures to keep your personal information secure. We also back-up all of your personal information on a regular basis.

9. E-Mail

9.1. We use email as the primary method of communication, and we will respond to your online contact request or direct contact request via email on the address you provided.

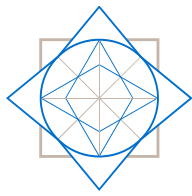
10. Children's Privacy

11.2. We will also retain Non-Personal Information for internal analysis purposes.



12. Access to and Correction of Personal Information

12.1. We do not maintain a customer database. All personal information is saved in email communications.

12.2. If you are a client and you can provide the necessary identification, you may request a record of all personal information we have and request removal where your information is no longer needed in the operation of our business for example record keeping for legal purposes.

13. Privacy Laws

13.1. The use of our website and any electronic transaction concluded with us are governed by the laws of the Republic of South Africa. If any user accesses our website from locations outside of the Republic of South Africa, that user is responsible for compliance with all local laws.

14. Changes to the Privacy Policy

14.1. Our website and/or any other information displayed on our website may change from time to time. As a result, at times it may be necessary for us to make changes to our website and this Privacy Policy. We reserve the right to update or modify our website and this Privacy Policy at any time and without prior notice to you. We will request your consent should any update or modification of our website or Privacy Policy adversely affect your rights set out herein.
