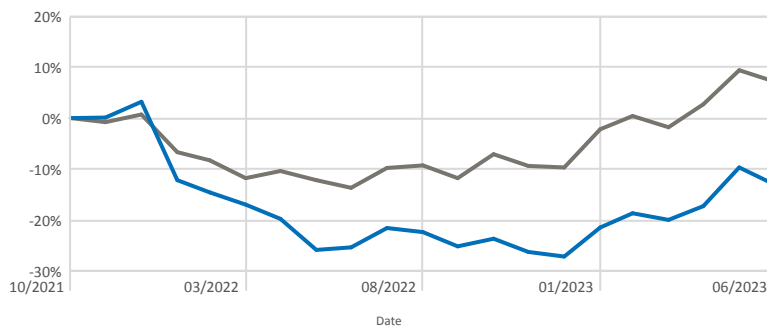
INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The Star BCI Global Growth Feeder Fund's investment objective is to achieve long-term capital appreciation at the risk of moderate short-term volatility of capital values. The investment returns generated are mostly capital gains over an ideal investment period of +5 years.

INVESTMENT POLICY

The portfolio will apart from assets in liquid form, invest solely in the participatory interests of the Star Global Growth Fund, established under the PIM Capital Ltd PCC domiciled in Mauritius. The underlying portfolio is a multi-asset flexible fund that invests primarily in liquid assets, listed equities, bonds, property equity and money market instruments as well as participatory interests in collective investment schemes, including exchange traded funds. To the extent that the assets in the portfolio are exposed to exchange rate risk, the manager may enter into financial transactions for the exclusive purpose of hedging such exchange rate risk subject to the conditions and limits as stipulated by the Act.

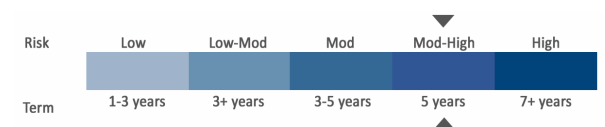

Moderate - High Risk

- This portfolio holds more equity exposure than a medium risk portfolio but less than a high-risk portfolio.
