
INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The Star BCI Stable Fund's investment objective is to provide investors with stable capital appreciation, net of investment fees over rolling three-year periods with no negative 12-month periods and to have the lowest category volatility versus the benchmark. The investment returns generated are mostly of an income nature with some returns coming from capital gains over an ideal investment period of 2-3 years.

INVESTMENT POLICY

The portfolio will invest in all asset classes including but not limited to equity, bond, money and property markets. The portfolio complies with prudential investment guidelines to the extent allowed for by the Act. To provide a limited level of capital protection, the portfolio's equity exposure may not exceed 40% of the portfolio's net asset value and the maximum property exposure is 10% of the portfolio's net asset value. In order to achieve its objective, the investments normally to be included in the portfolio may comprise a combination of assets in liquid form, money market instruments, interest bearing instruments and securities, preference shares, convertible equities and non-equity securities. The portfolio may invest in participatory interests or any other form of participation in portfolios of collective investment schemes or other similar collective investment schemes. The portfolio may from time to time invest in listed and unlisted financial instruments.
